

WHISTLERS' LODGE

MAIN HALL – this has tables and chairs. It has laminate flooring and makes a cosy space in the evenings when the curtains are closed. There is a large hatch into the kitchen for easy service of meals and drinks.

KITCHEN – well equipped with two cookers and a hob, sink, fridge, microwave, pots and pans, crockery, cutlery and ample cupboards for food storage.

BEDROOMS – each bedroom has either two, four or six bunk beds with mattresses, and heater.

BATHROOMS – there are two internal toilets and free showers are available within a minute walk in the modern shower block.

OUTSIDE SPACE – there is a grass area just outside with picnic benches for use of Whistlers' Lodge.

ACCESS – there are steps to the entrance, the other lodges have easier access and Beech Lodge a dedicated disabled room.

SAFETY – Whistlers Lodge is risk assessed and maintained to make all events as safe and fun as possible. There is an automatic fire detection system. All users should familiarise themselves with emergency exits and brief all participants.

READY FOR EVERYONE

We ask that only indoor shoes are worn inside so please put them on the kit lists. We provide cleaning equipment and products, we ask you to use them and leave the lodge ready for the next group. All equipment should be kept in the lodge, including chairs, to keep it all in good condition. As you would expect, there is no smoking allowed in the lodge to comply with British law.
